PLACEMAKING BUDAPEST – New public space functions in the city center

In the short six-week project, we will work in the 8th district of Budapest, Józsefváros, having a rich cultural and architectural identity and, at the same time, also social problems. In our target area (Népszínház Street), we will identify the urban characteristics of the area, and based on the already ongoing processes of the municipality and the local urban renewal company (RÉV8), we will work on the complex upgrading of the area through a public space intervention and a PLACEMAKING project.

Through the project, the task will be to give a conceptual design for the requalification of the whole area with urban furniture, pavilions, and various other amenities for the functional renewal of the area. The pavilions and the other amenities should be made from environmental conscious materials, structures and their energy demand must be minimized.
