Course description

Architectural design competences will be complemented by new disciplines from the Department of Urban Planning and Design and the Department of History of Architecture and Monument Preservation.

Iszkaszentgyörgy

The studio will explore the mansion of Iszkaszetgyörgy presented by the mayor: an underused Baroque composition of buildings in a large park dominating the peaceful village of 2000 inhabitants. After the site visit we will give a new program for the buildings and design contemporary functions in the park, inspired by the imaginary functions and composition rules a Baroque park of this size usually had. The studio will give new knowledge on history of architecture, monument preservation, urban planning and landscape design, inspiring students to adopt new architectural designs to such disciplines. The work will help the local municipality to get new ideas on the development of the site.
