Building Construction Technical Training

Aims:

The purpose of the building construction technical training is for the students to gain an appropriate insight by practising in one of the construction industry fields during the training period and to gain experience that can be used in the rest of the training and at the start of their career.

Time:

Completion of the building construction technical training is compulsory for BSc and 5-year Integrated MSc programs. The total duration of the traineeship is four weeks, which can be completed between the 2nd and 9th semesters and is **recommended to be completed after the 6th semester**. Even if the traineeship is completed in instalments, the signature can only be obtained after completing the entire traineeship period.

Location:

Construction technical training must be spent on a construction site or in other companies engaged in construction activities (e. g. project preparation, management, real estate development) in a position appropriate to the student's level of knowledge. The traineeship can be carried out at a company whose scope of activity includes at least one of the given professional fields (e. g. construction, management, real estate development) and whose operation and the employment of students as trainees follow the legal framework in force.

As the Faculty of Architecture has a separate system for the design practice, the building construction technical training **cannot be completed in a design office and related tasks** (e. g. planning, surveying, and design management).

Exceptions to the above are **construction**, **design and surveying camps organised by BME departments**, the organisers of which have **consulted** the Department of Construction Technology and Management **in advance**. Participation in such field trips **may be at most one week** of the mandatory four weeks of the traineeship period.

Students search for companies themselves, as **there is no pre-qualification** from the Department of Construction Technology and Management. It is also possible to spend the traineeship abroad, but a certificate in English or a certified Hungarian translation is required.

Method of acceptance:

The completion method is **registering** the subject *Building Construction Technical Training* in the NEPTUN system and **submitting the certificate** of completion and the **report** in the same semester, according to the requirements on the Faculty's website.

How to submit the certificates:

Certificates can be submitted at the end of each semester, in the first week of the exam period, at the collection point in the department. The department cannot be held responsible for certificates submitted at the wrong time or left in the wrong place!

The order of registration for the traineeship:

In the semester following the completion of the four weeks and obtaining a certificate of completion, the course BMEEPEKA580 Building Construction Technical Training must be registered.

The subject must be taken only once; the earliest time for this is the semester after obtaining all certificates, and the latest is the diploma semester. The traineeship is documented in NEPTUN as a signature in the semester of taking the subject and submitting the certification(s).
